



Guided Learning on Water and Sanitation - (GLoWS)

HOW CAN YOU TACKLE CHALLENGES IN WATER AND SANITATION?

In many developing countries, the number of improved water supply and sanitation systems is rapidly growing, but many are facing important problems as a result of limitations in management and maintenance. To tackle these problems, a special problem based learning and training approach was developed to support staff in the water and sanitation sector at community and municipal level from government agencies, private sector and NGOs. To improve provided assistance; establishing possible risks and solutions together with communities and service providers this training known as: Guided Learning on Water and Sanitation (GLoWS) is provided.

GLOWS MODULES

GLoWS uses a modular framework empowering participants to help recognize basic water, sanitation problems and to plan applicable solutions jointly with stakeholders. The following modules are included in the course: (1) Community Water Supply; (2) Water Quality risk management; (3) Water supply improvements; (4) Sustainable multiple use water services; (5) Sanitation and hygiene; (6) Management and finance of WASH; (7) Process facilitation; and (8) Community Water and Sanitation Action Plans.

PARTICIPANTS

Courses are meant for practitioners and professionals working at public (governmental/ and non-governmental) and private organizations in the fields of water, water resources and sanitation. Course groups will consist of a maximum of 20 participants who will work in small teams on their real-time professional challenges.

COSTS

The costs for the training include three separate weeks of intensive training materials, refreshments as well as lunch and field visits.
